Vino Bianco

10 Lionel Osmin *DRY* Rose, France

Nothing says summer like a perfectly dry rose, strawberry on the palate, but with grit & acidity.

11 Riff Pinot Grigio, Veneto

The name refers to a reef that existed along a former sea bed where the grapes are farmed. The soil and the environment add texture and a hint of salinity to the wine.

12 Urban Riesling, Mosel Germany

Ripe, tropical flavors of peach & honeysuckle, the wine is well balanced with sweetness and acidity giving your mouth ripe fruits with a too sweet finish..

13 Lionel Osmin Sauvignon Blanc, France

A great summer wine with hints of grapefruit, tangerine and lime; crisp and refreshing.

14 Grayson Cellars Chardonnay, California

Bold fruit flavors of pear & green apple with a dry, creamy finish of vanilla and a touch of oak.

15 Cielo Prosecco, Italy

A crowd pleaser. Easy to drink with fresh sweet fruits and a slight effervescence.

16 Ruby Donna Moscato, Italy

A sweet fun wine that has just the right amount of bubbles.

20 San Huberto *Reserve* Malbec, Argentina

Full flavored, with earthy undertones and dark fruits, robust with a soft finish.

21 Villa Poggio Salvi *Caspagnolo* Chianti dei Colli Senesi

A classic Chianti, with dried cherry fruit, medium body, bold acidity, dry finish.

23 Peirano Estates *Six Clones* Merlot, California

An attractive nose with bold, ripe fruits of plum & blackberry, hints of spicy oak on the finish.

25 DeLoach *Heritage Reserve* Cabernet Sauvignon, California

A full-bodied Cabernet, with sweet cherry fruit with soft tannins and a touch of white pepper.

27 Canaletto Pinot Noir, Veneto

This Pinot Noir is light with a soft cherry fruit, hints of spice on the finish.

201 Dievole Chianti Classico

\$ 45

A predominance of Bing cherry and red fruits complete the taste experience, the minerality and acidity, well-integrated, youthful but elegant. The finish is pleasant with persistent tannins.

202 Villa Cafaggio Chianti Classico Riserva

\$ 65

Firm ripe fruit aromas with blackcurrant undertones. It offers deep concentrated flavors of red cherry, dark fruits and dried tobacco leaves, tannins soft with a hint of cedar.

203 Villa Poggio Salvi (*Biondi Santi's 2nd Label*) Rosso di Montalcino

\$ 45

Brunello is great but can be expensive. Rosso di Montalcino a younger version of Brunello; it is made with the same grapes, but aged in oak barrels for a shorter time period. This wine offers ripe almost sweet cherry fruit that is delicious, with a long and dry finish.

204 Poliziano Vino Nobile di Montepulciano

\$ 60

This wine has many of the characteristics shown in Brunello. It is well structured, with longevity, intense on the nose, but not exaggerated, bold and expressive, dry finish.

205 Podere La Vigna Brunello di Montalcino

\$ 95

Elegant yet bold and complex, dominated by plum and black cherry fruit on the palate with earthy undertones that are the trademarks of Brunello. This is an ample, well balanced beauty of a wine full of sweet tannins, bright acid, and plenty of fruit that leads to a dry dusty finish.

206 Ceralta Scire Bolgheri - Super Tuscan

\$ 45

Blend of Cabernet and Merlot. It is easy to drink, medium bodied with hints of blackberry, raspberry, spice, leather and tobacco. This might be one of the best values on the menu.

207 Petra Hebo Super Tuscan

\$ 60

Sangiovese, one of the oldest, most revered grapes cultivated in Tuscany. This is a blend using those old Sangiovese vines with Cab and Merlot to give it a bigger mouthfeel. Intense aroma of black cherry, red fruits with a noticeable hint of eucalyptus, balance, rich & dry.

208 Aia Vecchia SorUgo Bolgheri - Super Tuscan

\$ 75

Bolgheri is the region where Super Tuscan's originated. A blend of Cabernet, Merlot & Cab. Franc. It is full bodied with aromatic nose of jam fruits and hints of vanilla. On the palate it is ripe, full of silky, long tannins, dry with elements of mocha and espresso.

Wines of Piedmont

211 Vietti Tre Vigne Dolcetto d'Alba

\$ 40

Purple red color, the Dolcetto has black cherry, raspberry and hint of blueberries aromas. An unoaked wine, this medium bodied red has soft tannins, moderate acidity and good balance.

212 Cantine Povero Barbaresco

\$ 50

Barbaresco is produced similar to Barolo: same grapes, same region, different hill top, but it is softer, more floral, delicate and easier on the palate; hence it is known as the wine of queens.

213 Vietti Perbacco Nebbiolo (*Baby Barolo*)

\$ 60

Vietti is known for producing some of the best \$200 plus bottles of Barolo's from their 5 cru estates. Every year they taste every barrel and some barrels are not considered good enough to be labeled Barolo so the winery declassifies the wine to maintain that high standard level. So what do they do with those barrels you ask? They label them "Perbacco"

214 Cantine Povero Barolo

\$ 65

In the early 18th century winemakers started to produce Barolo in a dry style. It was then that the King of France discovered the wine and loved it so much that he would buy the entire production each year. The wine soon became known as "the wine of Kings".

215 Rivetto Serralunga Barolo

\$ 120

A premier single vineyard, on the nose dry rose petals, on the palate ripe cherries with hints of tobacco and black licorice, dry but not aggressive with layers of complexity & texture.

Wines of Veneto

220 Cent'Anni Valpolicella Ripasso

\$ 45

Amarone and Valpolicella are produced from the same grapes grown in the same region: The difference is Ripasso is the second passing of the Amarone skins, so not as intense as Amarone.

221 Cent'Anni Amarone

\$ 80

Amarone is a wine produced from dried grape. Hand-selected superior bunches of grapes that receive maximum sun exposure are drying for 4 months until the grapes have lost 40-50% of their water weight. The raisin-like grapes are then pressed for their juice, fermented into a dry wine and then soaked in the fermented concentrated skins before aging for in small wooden casks for 5 yrs. The result is a huge intense wine like no other.

222 Tenute Fiorebelli Amarone

\$ 120

Full bodied and extremely dry, with bold black cherry flavors, hints of dried fruits, chocolate and spice. If you prefer an Amarone that offers rich, complex flavors then this is for you.

Vino Rosso

Wines of France

231 Chateau Louvie Saint Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux \$ 45

A Blend of Merlot & Cabernet Franc, this wine is a bright, with fresh and earthy blackcurrant aromas on the nose. Ripe cassis fruit with mocha, smooth and lush textures.

232 Chateau Monbrison "Bouquet de Monbrison" Margaux, Bordeaux \$ 80

60% Cabernet % 40% Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot, this wine is a dry, medium bodied down to earthred filled with red fruits, laced with leafy tobacco and cedar spice.

Wine of California

241 Bogle Pinot Noir, California \$ 40

Bright berry fruit followed by a well-balanced palate and soft suggestions of tea leaves and violets. Toasty vanilla winds itself throughout the finish: long, silky and elegant.

242 Calera Central Coast Pinot Noir, Central Coast- Monterey \$ 60

The deep ocean water of the Monterey Bay creates cool nights which help extend the growing season here. It's the main reason why this wine shows that rich, old world style. It has plenty of flavor with ripe, dark cherry fruit that offers a earthy, rustic finish that is both dry and spicy.

243 Trefethen Merlot, Napa Valley \$ 50

A bold, robust Merlot, with hints of black cherry, vanilla and dry plum tones, tannins that are rich and spicy with toasty oak on the finish, complex and well structured.

244 Villa San Juliette Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles \$ 45

Hand-picked from the steepest hillside vineyard this wine offers aromas of toffee, nutmeg, and blackberry intermingle with cherry, rosemary, and gingerbread notes. It is ripe and rich, full-bodied with chocolate like tannins and a leathery finish.

245 Mill Creek Cabernet Sauvignon, Dry Creek Valley \$ 60

The wine offers: floral notes of dried fruits and a hint of powerful vanilla sent, bold flavors of plum, cassis, blackberry and a mocha coffee, while the finish is incredible long, extremely dry.

246 Farmstead Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley \$ 70

Vibrantly rich, multi-layered wine where the lush fruit dominates as streams across the palate, but the acidity remains lively, juicy and focused. The tannins are long, youthful.

247 Frank Family Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley \$ 110

The bouquet is loaded with intense aromas of cassis, hints of dry mission figs and ripe plum, enhanced by cedar and leather scents. The palate is lush with savory dark fruit and a hint of sweet oak and black pepper. The wine is well structured with soft tannins.

248 Duckhorn Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley \$ 125

Aromas of ripe currant, marzipan and tobacco, intense flavors of blackberry and black cherry, supported by a subtle framework of French oak, which adds nuance, depth and dimension.

249 Duckhorn Decoy Meritage, Napa Valley \$ 50

A blend of 5 Bordeaux grapes: Cabernet, Merlot, Cab Franc, Petite Verdot and Malbec. It offer ripe fruit of cherry and blackberry with a hint of tobacco and soft, dry tannins on the finish.

- 101 Ritratti Pinot Grigio, Trentino** \$ 45
Not your typical Pinot Grigio. This hand-crafted wine expresses quality, not quantity. Aromas of juicy melon and Acacia flowers pour from the glass, while the wine is crisp with hints of minerals, Meyer lemons, yellow plums and a touch of honey, clean and dry of the finish.
- 102 Santa Margherita Pinot Grigio, Italy** \$ 55
One of the best known Pinot Grigio in the world. The wineries goal is to create consistency, they achieve that by blend Pinot Grigio grapes around the region. It is crisp and refreshing.
- 105 Aia Vecchia Vermentino, Tuscany** \$ 35
In the glass, the wine is straw yellow with pale green hues. The bouquet is fresh with zesty aromas of freshly cut grass, grapefruit and hints of salt air. On the palate, the wine has a creamy and round mouthfeel with bright acidity accompanied by hints of limestone and a slight earthiness. The finish is lengthy, dry and refreshing
- 106 Tre Fiori Greco di Tufo, Campania** \$ 40
The bouquet offers delicious aromas of almonds and honeysuckle. The palate is well-balanced, crisp, lively and complex, with a refreshing minerality and sensations of grapefruit, melon and orange zest. The finish is elegant and lingering.

Alternative White Wines

- 110 Stoneburn Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough New Zealand** \$ 40
Ripe tropical fruits with gooseberry, grapefruit, passion fruit and guava. The finish is crisp, refreshing, bright and enticing. It is the perfect summer wine or with any shellfish dish.
- 111 Chateau Pilet Blanc, Bordeaux** \$ 35
Classic blend of 60% Sauvignon Blanc & 40% Semillon, It is crisp and slightly herbaceous with citrus tones, hints of grapefruits and a rich finish that lingers on the palate.
- 112 St. Urbans-hof Ocfender Bockstein Kabinett Riesling, Mosel, Germany** \$ 45
Ripe, tropical fruit flavors of peach and melon, The flavors are bold but balance by its acidity and texture. This wine may seem sweet at first, but is semi-dry on the finish.
- 113 Trefethen Double T Chardonnay** \$ 45
A classic Napa Valley Chardonnay with green apple, creamy lemon, pineapple and vanilla headline the aromas on this medium bodied Chardonnay. A chorus of tropical fruit and spice dance on the palate. The grand finale is a long and lavish finish
- 114 DeLoach Russian River Chardonnay, Russian River** \$ 55
This Chardonnay immediately entices you with its citrus notes of lime and mandarin, along with green cardamom, nutmeg and baked apple. Upon first sip you will enjoy flavors of apple with a slight creaminess. The balanced acidity gives you a creamy, soft mouthfeel that builds with intensity, it offers a racy structure that is usually found in the Russian River area. The wine ends with a long and intense finish that lingering on the palate.
- 115 Rombauer Chardonnay, Carneros, Napa Valley** \$ 75
Enticing aromas of vanilla, peach & mango are layered with apricots, creme brulee, butter and a slight minerality. Those scents are echoed as flavors on the creamy, rich palate, along with peach, pie crust and baking spices. The long, smooth finish is marked by mouthwatering acidity

Sparkling Wines

- 120 Canti Prosecco, Italy** \$ 40
This Prosecco is crowd pleaser, fruity and fragrant with clean notes of citrus, pears and apples along with slight hints of wisteria and elder. Fine bubbles caress the palate, while intense flavors of apples and peaches give the wine a pleasing finish.
- 121 Contaldi Castaldi Franciacorta Brut Rose, Franciacorta Italy** \$ 50
If you are looking for bubbles and not think Franciacotra, then you drastically mistaken. Franciacorta is the premier sparkling wine of Italy. Just as if France they predominantly use Chardonnay and Pinot Noir for their sparkling wine. This wine is refine and elegant, with a lush mouthfeel typical of Franciacorta. The nose has notes of wild berries, fresh rose petals, hints of apple and tropical fruit. On the mouth it is structured, crisp, lively, tangy & sensual. The finish is long and well balanced. Just as good if not better than Champagne, but half the
- 123 Moet and Chandon Imperial Champagne, France** \$ 90
Champagne method - means that it is bottled before fermentation. An expensive process called "Riddling" where the gas and some yeast become trapped in the bottle, hand turned daily, letting the yeast work its way to the cork before freezing the neck of the bottle to remove.
- 124 Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Champagne, France** \$120
Veuve Clicquot creates pure elegance again and again. The Yellow label is blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay with bold tropical fruit that offer great texture with a dry, crisp finish.
